RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT GHOST GUN REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, Ghost guns are un-serialized, kit-built firearms that are not traceable like ordinary firearms and they subvert existing firearms regulations, the sale and purchase of functional completed firearms are regulated by California and Federal law. This has created a robust market for unfinished firearms;

WHEREAS, California legislation AB 879 has be approved is it limited kit-built firearms that are not traceable like ordinary firearms, prohibits the possession or distribution of unserialized parts, but does not include 3D printing of unserialized firearms;

WHEREAS, LULAC, should recommend advocating ordinance that bans "ghost guns" in efforts to reduce mass shootings from occurring;

WHEREAS, reports have shown that ghost guns are appealing to extremists, as indicted in the Joint Terrorism Assessment Team (JCAT) and have been tied to Hate Crimes against our Latino population and other minorities groups;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the LULAC District 14 allies efforts to our California legislators and request that legislation also include the creation of ghost guns by using 3D printing options.

and that the citizens of National LULAC join the LULAC Membership in requesting that ghost guns get added to all Federal gun control act.
